


Denyse believes that youth depression is one of the biggest challenges facing Mozambique and Africa as a whole. "The main reason is that some African parents don't know what depression is and don't believe that it exists, and that is real. So it is up to us youth to integrate youth depression prevention efforts into places where youth are most readily accessed."

She added, "Interventions to prevent youth depression may benefit from a focus on enhancing family understanding of youth depression. We need to attend to family processes that influence depression risk and that promote depression prevention."

Denyse also believes that the key issues that need to be addressed in order to promote gender equality and empower women in Mozambique and Africa are increasing women's representation in leadership and decision making, redistributing care work and productive resources, and empower-

ing women small holders.

With these issues in mind, Denyse is currently working on projects to encourage young graduates and those who were not lucky enough to have access to education to learn entrepreneurship and how to save from an early age. "Where they will be taught to work in cooperatives according to their skills in order to reduce the highest rate of unemployment in youth."





Miss Environment Philippines Shares Her Inspiring Story Of Overcoming Challenges




4. Start reaching out.


5. Leaner Muscles.


Still in 2019 she took part in Miss Cavendish University and came out in top five (5), she never gave up and because of my zeal to succeed





One of the greatest achievement's in my life is when I discovered my purpose - to know the reason why I was born on this earth.



German. Her school dismisses her at 13:00, giving her enough time to attend to her other activities and assignments.


