




Lebogang also shared her approach to handling criticism and setbacks. "I do not pay attention to criticism at all," she

In a striking move that has captured public attention, Winta Russom, the Miss Universe Eritrea titleholder, took to social media to voice her grievances against the Miss Universe Eritrea organization. Her announcement reflects not only personal conviction but also raises questions about the integrity of beauty pageants.

Winta shared her decision with heartfelt sincerity, stating:

"This decision wasn't easy, especially knowing how much hope you've placed in me. But I must stand by my principles and refuse to participate in something that doesn't align with my values."


Winta was scheduled to compete in the Miss Universe Eritrea pageant, but her resolve was shaken by irregularities she witnessed during the voting process. "If there is a specific time for voting to close, shouldn't the votes available at that exact closing time be simply counted?"

This lack of clarity and perceived unfairness led Winta to lose trust in the competition. She emphasized that she did not want to waste her supporters' time or money, nor did she want to be part of a "rigged game." Her commitment

to integrity ultimately guided her decision to withdraw.



Despite her initial optimism about the competition, Winta felt that the circumstances had shifted unfavorably. She remarked:

"When certain truths come to light, it becomes difficult to continue in the same manner."

"If the website is open, any votes cast will be counted."

They urged supporters not to wait until the last minute to cast their votes.

Lubone's commitment to community service and modeling makes her an exemplary role model. She envisions herself inspiring young girls and women to break stereotypes and pursue their dreams.


